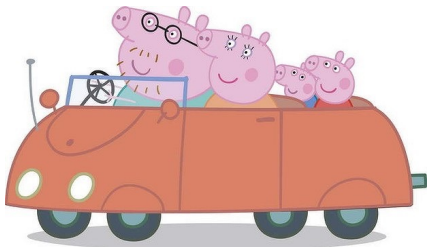

Oct. 22/17, The Miracle of the Dead Son (20th Sunday after Pentecost)

1. True or false: the widow's son died.

1. True. The widow had one son who died.
2. Luke 7:11-16: **11** Soon afterward[a] he went to a city called Na'in, and his disciples and a great crowd went with him. **12** As he drew near to the gate of the city, behold, a man who had died was being carried out, the only son of his mother, and she was a widow; and a large crowd from the city was with her. **13** And when the Lord saw her, he had compassion on her and said to her, "Do not weep." **14** And he came and touched the bier, and the bearers stood still. And he said, "Young man, I say to you, arise." **15** And the dead man sat up, and began to speak. And he gave him to his mother. **16** Fear seized them all; and they glorified God, saying, "A great prophet has arisen among us!" and "God has visited his people!" **17** And this report concerning him spread through the whole of Judea and all the surrounding country.¹

2. True or false: Jesus is only a prophet

1. False. Jesus is God the Son, the second person of the Holy Trinity.
2. The people who witnessed the raising of the widow's dead son said that "a great prophet had risen among us" and "God has visited his people!" What those people didn't understand is that Jesus, though he preached in synagogues all over, has the power of God because He is God. Peter finally declares Jesus to be Christ later in Luke's Gospel (Luke 9:18-20). Interestingly enough, demons knew who Jesus was from the beginning of His ministry (Luke 4: 38-41).
3. Many prophets popped up throughout the history of the Old Testament, such as Isaiah, Elijah, and Samuel. John the Baptist was the final prophet to pop up and point the way directly to Jesus.
